What a year it has been; snow in March and April followed by a scorcher of a Summer and the last few months nothing but rain.

And let's not forget our BIG MOVE in June. It was hard work to get it all done in a week but we did manage it with quite a few late nights. We are all settled in now and loving it. Thank you to everyone who gave us their support, help and all those beautiful cards!

Fore Street has given us more space, more light, more fabrics and notions and more customers!

2019 will bring more of what you have come to expect from us like new and exciting courses, new and returning tutors, more coach trips to quilt shows but most importantly NEW fabrics! The new year will see Tilda return to its floral staple with a range called 'Apple Butter' and we're very excited about the third quilting cotton range from 'Liberty'. Both of these should be with us in February and will be high on your "want" list.

As always, in January we will be holding an OPEN DAY to show off the samples for all of our courses, classes and workshops and give you a chance to meet some of our fabulous tutors. Please mark your diaries on Saturday 26th January 10am till 4pm. Of course, if you see something in the brochure that takes your fancy, you can book in from Tuesday 8th January onwards. Some courses are always popular and fill up fast so don't wait too long! You're always welcome to contact us to get more details.

In other news, our layering-up service is proving very popular! Plenty of quilters have saved their backs, knees and patience by paying us to do it for them. "Layering-up" is where we sandwich and tack the quilttop, wadding and backing together ready for you to start quilting. We use a Microstitch "gun" that uses tiny tacks to keep all three layers secured together. These are then easily removed with a special tool after quilting. Prices start from just £15 for a lap quilt and go up to £25 for a King size quilt. All you'll need to do is drop everything off with us and we have it ready for you to collect a week later.

We also still offer our 'Bespoke Bunting' service where we make personalised bunting for new babies, birthdays, weddings and even businesses (pop into Hair @ No.4 and you'll see our handiwork!). This has also led to us making Christmas stockings, personalised aprons and cutlery pouches for camper vans...so if someone asks, do send them over!

Absolute Beginners Patchwork and Quilting with Sunny

Hand sewing

As it says in the title, this course is for beginners and absolute novices alike. Starting from the beginning, each month you'll be taught different "blocks" increasing in difficulty. Once the blocks are finished we will concentrate on sashing and borders before quilting and binding. We will take you through making this 'Sampler Quilt' step-by-step and from start to finish. We use hand sewing for this course because it gives pupils the best basis and understanding of how fabric goes together. These principles can then be adapted for a sewing machine after the course is complete. Sample in the shop

Free Motion Quilting with Erica Manser**Machine sewing****£ 70.00****2 full days from 10 - 4****Saturday Feb 23 and March 16 OR****Friday May 3 and May 17**

This beginner's course will teach you how to set up your sewing machine to free machine quilt different patterns and then you will be shown how to complete a variety of different patterns. At the end of the course you will have your very own pattern book of designs to refer back to – Erica will show you how to construct the pattern book and how to add to this. Homework will be to practice the designs and then the second part of the course will be to bring in an item to actually machine quilt. The first two courses were very popular, so please book sooner rather than later.

Yes, we know: Christmas is only a couple of weeks ago but if you would like to have this quilt ready for next Christmas, you will have to get started now. Each block is appliqued using your preferred method with machine sewn sashing around it which is made up from lots of scrappy strips and small blocks. Rotary cutting experience is necessary.

If you have always wanted to learn to sew your own clothes or have had a long break from it but want to regain your confidence, this course is for you. For beginners we will recommend certain patterns but essentially the pattern choice is entirely up to you. Jacquie will make sure your chosen garment fits you perfectly and you'll feel proud to wear. Please note: You will need to bring your own sewing machine for this course.

Brimfield Block Cushion with Sunny
