Courses

<u>Please note</u>: for any classes/courses that mention 'machine sewing', you will need to bring your own sewing machine to the class. Do make sure that the machine is clean (all fluff removed from the inside etc.) and in good working order and bring all leads, accessories and the manual.





EPP Heart Cushion Myriam Hand and a bit of machine sewing 3 Wednesday mornings 10-12.30pm May 1 / May 29 / July 31 £60

This wonderful 20" floor cushion is so very pretty and fun to make. The front and sides are English Paper Pieced and you will put a zip in the back. You will be shown how to make bias binding from a Fat Quarter to bind the edges for a neat finish to the cushion.







Simple Days BOM (Block of the month) Myriam Hand and machine sewing 4 Tuesday mornings 10-12.30pm May 7 / June 18 / July 30 / Sept 3 £80

When making this wallhanging it was never intended to be a course but by popular demand we have done just that. Small appliqued and embroidered blocks surrounded by some very simple borders makes this a wonderful project to have on the go. Perfect for using up your scraps and bits from your stash.



EPP Table Centre Sunny Handsewing 2 Thursday mornings 10-12.30pm May 9 and June 20 £40

Enjoy 2 mornings of handsewing making this beautiful table centre. It measures approx. 30" in diameter which means nice, big pieces to sew together. If you're new to English Paper Piecing (EPP), this is a great project to start with. We'll take you through the whole process, step-by-step from making your templates to sewing it all together.



Sewing Accessories Folder Diane Hand and machine sewing 3 Wednesday mornings 10-12.30pm May 15 / June 19 / July 17 £60

A beautiful folder to keep all your bits and bobs together. There are numerous pockets and a large zipped pouch in the back.

A useful folder to store an ongoing Work-In-Progress. A nice project to combine embroidery with patchwork and show off your sewing skills.



Kimono Dressing Gown - Beginners Dressmaking Myriam and Sunny Machine sewing 2 Saturdays 10-3pm May 18 and June 1 £85

Learn to make this simple, yet elegant kimono dressing gown in just 2 days. No previous dressmaking experience required, this is a great project for beginners and those wanting to return to dressmaking after a long time. Basic sewing machine skills is all that's needed.

Free Motion Quilting

Learn how to use your sewing machine to quilt freehand patterns. You will start off with squiggles and then learn how easy it is to turn those squiggles to numerous different patterns. Once you know how; it's just a matter of practice to finesse those patterns. A great skill to have in your arsenal and something that looks difficult but is actually very simple.



From Basics To Beyond - Beginners Patchwork and Quilting and Beyond...

3 afternoons from 1pm – 3.30pm
Saturday: May 25 / June 22 / July 27

This course is aimed at complete beginners who want to make a beautiful patchwork quilt. From start to finish, Ruth with her years and years of experience, will guide you through each month's block (of your choice) followed by sashing, quilting, borders and binding. Everything is sewn by hand making it portable and mindful. You won't finish a quilt in these 3 sessions but you can make a good start. We run this course each term meaning you can sign up again in September and continue your sewing.

Dressmaking

May 30 / June 13 / June 27
£60

Do you want to make a simple but unique garment in a small, supportive, and friendly class? This course will guide you through the reading and understanding of a commercial pattern, cutting your fabric pieces, and constructing your garment. The aim of the course is for you to gain confidence in your sewing abilities. To make a simple garment that fits you well and has a professional

finish. We want your garment to be one you love and are proud to wear. More importantly, we hope you will gain skills you can put to use in future dressmaking projects.

We have a maximum of 6 in this class so please book early!



Jelly Stars Quilt Myriam Machine sewing 2 Wednesday mornings 10-12.30pm June 5 and June 12 £40

If you want make a beautiful quilt that looks much more complicated than it really is, this is the one for you. The stars will appear as by magic and the whole quilt comes together nice and quickly. Rotary cutting and basic machine sewing skills are a must for this short course.



Zadie Jumpsuit Myriam and Sunny Machine sewing 2 Saturdays 10-3pm June 8 and June 15 £80

If you're one of the many people who have complimented us on our jumpsuits over the years, it will have been a Zadie (We both have five at least and they all look different). Not difficult to make as it hasn't got a zip nor buttons or buttonholes. It suits all shapes and sizes and is very comfortable to wear (yes, you can get out of it quickly to go to the toilet...), so why not have a go at dressmaking with this one? Please note: You will need to purchase this pattern from the makers before the class which will be an additional £20.



Pumpkin Tablerunner

3 Tuesday mornings 10-12.30
June 11 / June 25 / July 9
£60

It is a bit early to think about Autumn and pumpkins but if you want to have this finished when the leaves are turning, let's get started! You will need strips of fabric in lovely warm autumn colours and I will show you how to make them into this lovely table runner or a pile of comfy cushions.

Rotary cutting and basic sewing skills are a must.



Block Binder Erica Machine sewing 2 Fridays mornings from 10am – 12.30pm June 21 and July 5 £40

Back by VERY popular demand! Make a handy 'book binder' to store your readymade blocks nice and flat. Useful if making blocks in a class setting, block of the month, or before you assemble a quilt. Easy to make using odd blocks that you may have hanging around and you can add as many pages as you like.





Painterly Petals Quilt

June 29 and July 13
£40

If you have always liked to make a quilt but haven't got the skills, then this is your chance to make a start. Some pretty squares combined with plainer ones and a simple but effective border finishes this lovely bright quilt. Will look just as nice in more muted colours.



Cord making Louisa 2 Tuesday mornings 10-12.30pm July 2 and July 23 £45 (includes foam disc)

Come and try something completely new but just as much fun, mindful and addictive as sewing.

Learn the Japanese art of Kumihimo braiding to make intricate patterned cords for fastening and embellishing anything from garments to bags or even shoes. They make ideal drawstrings for your handmade bags. The course will run over two mornings and starts with making a basic 16 strand braid using Japanese foam discs, then moves on to other patterns and finishing the ends. No previous experience is needed, this course is ideal for beginners.

The "Oh how cute!" Calendar Month-of-the-month (like a block of the month but because it's a calendar....)

Myriam and Diane Hand and machine sewing 3 Wednesday mornings 10-12.30pm July 3 / July 10 / October 2 £60

A perpetual calendar with mini quilts for the dates and days of the week and a pretty box to store them all in. A bit of applique, a bit of embroidery and a bit of embellishment. This is one of those projects that will give you so much joy to make and once it is finished the joy of seeing it change every day of the week. Applique can be done with fusible web or needleturn. Every crafter needs one of these!!



3 Zip Pouch

A much-admired and very useful pouch with 3 zipped compartments.

Perfect for your sewing bits and pieces or make up and they make wonderfully thoughtful gifts.

DAY WORKSHOPS



Simple Tunic Top - Beginners Dressmaking Sunny Machine Sewing Saturday May 4 10 - 3pm £45

Learn to make this easy floaty top in just 1 day! Made up of just 3 pattern pieces, no sleeves to set in, no zips, darts or buttonholes and one of those tops you can throw on with everything. Perfect for the summer and people interested in beginning their garment-making journey. Only basic sewing machine skills needed.

Rotary Cutting Myriam Saturday May 11 10am – 12.30pm £20

Is it a case of 'all the gear and no idea' with your rotary equipment or have you been wondering what all the fuss is about? This will be a good class for you! Rotary cutting is an important part of modern patchwork and you will have seen all the contestants use theirs on the Sewing Bee. In this class we will teach you about the rotary cutter itself and how to use it safely and accurately, we will cover how to use and maintain your cutting board and the use of different rulers. Most of our classes require the ability to rotary cut.



Kinomichi - Beginners Patchwork Myriam and Sunny Machine sewing Friday May 24 10am - 3pm £40

If you want to learn to make a quilt very quickly or are new to patchwork, this popular class is for you! You will learn rotary cutting and machine piecing. This quilt comes together very quickly so makes a wonderful lastminute gift.



Learn To Use Your Sewing Machine Myriam and Sunny Tuesday May 28 10am - 1pm £25

If you're new to sewing or have just acquired a sewing machine and you're not sure how to use it, come to our class and by 1pm you'll be best of friends. We cover the anatomy and workings of the machine, maintenance, stitch patterns, button holes, zips and a whole lot more.



Pyjama Shorts / Lounge Shorts - Beginners Dressmaking Sunny Machine sewing Saturday July 6 10-3pm £45 (includes pattern)

The easiest way to get into dressmaking if you're a beginner and fantastic shorts to just throw on whether for bed or casually around the house when it's warm. These pyjama bottom shorts feature in-seam pockets and an elasticated waist making them both comfy and practical. Easy to wash, sew and wear. Sizes XXS – 4XL.



"Twinchies" 2 Inch Embroidery Patches Barbara Handsewing Tuesday July 16 10-12.30 £25

These are embroidery miniatures that will end up as 2" squares. They can be tiny landscapes, flowers, trees etc or a design of choice. You will use stranded cottons and various stitches on a coloured background. They can be used in a multi felt frame or as individual pieces, even a necklace with suitable backing. Only one can be made in the workshop but you'll have the knowledge to make many more at home.



Fabric Box Making
Viv
Hand sewing
Saturday July 20 10-12.30pm
£25 (includes pre-cut card for the box and wadding)
A basic box-making technique to make a box approximately 4" square and 3" deep, but the method can be adapted to your own size specifications in your own time. Some stitching and glueing involved using your choice of material.

Pre-cut card and full instruction sheet will be supplied. by Viv. Make a special gift box, or keep it yourself to stash those bits and pieces!

Maximum of 6 in this class so please book early!
